MT4T is a teacher resource kit that promotes the use of mobile technology in Southeast Asian educational settings. The kit provides a basic guide for using mobile devices, such as smartphones and tablets and their accompanying applications, as tools for teaching and learning in the classroom for personal and professional development. It introduces the three most widely used mobile technology platforms—iOS, Android, and Windows—and how they may be used in conjunction with social media, such as Facebook and Twitter, to enhance student learning and professional collaboration among teachers. MT4T is specially focused on how mobile devices can be used to promote the development of higher order thinking skills (HOTS) of students and teachers.

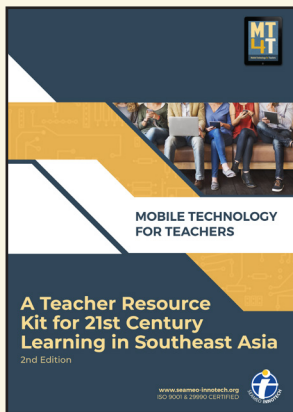
MT4T e-Books

Classification of Users



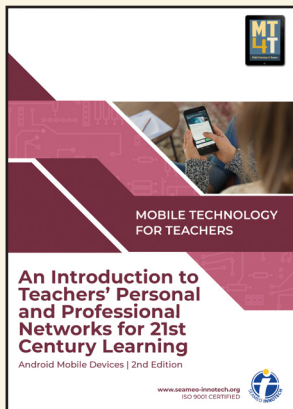


An Introduction to Mobile Technology for Teachers (2nd ed.)

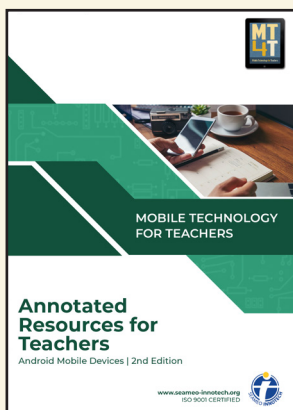
An Introduction to Teachers' Personal and Professional Learning Networks for 21st Century Learning

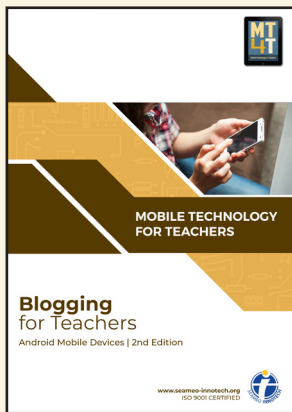
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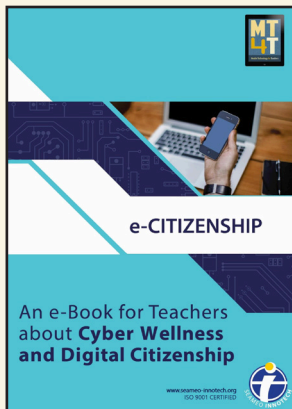
Blogging for Teachers (2nd ed.)

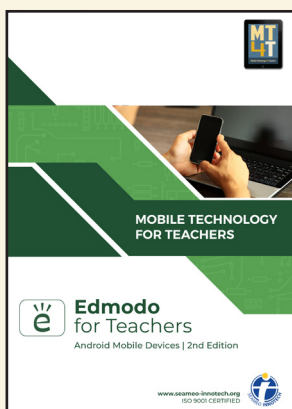
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Edmodo for Teachers (2nd ed.)

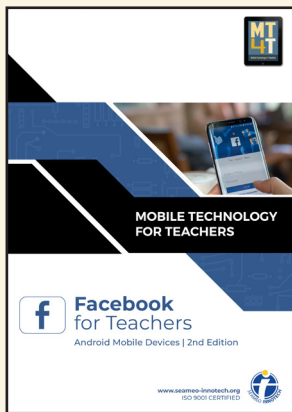

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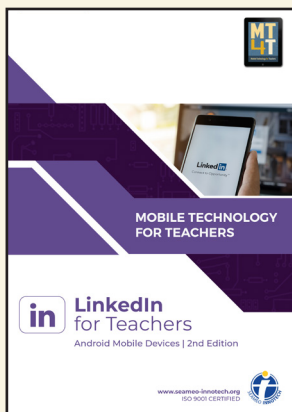
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LinkedIn for Teachers (2nd ed.)

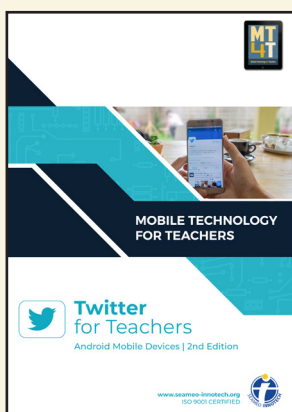
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Twitter for Teachers (2nd ed.)

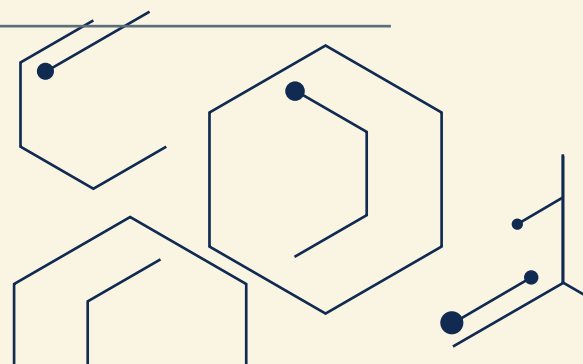

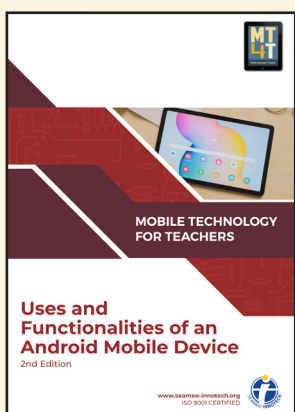
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Uses and Functionalities of Mobile Devices for Teachers (2nd ed.)
