



## **TIC-TAC-TOE Q&A**

Pre-game Instructions: Draw the figure below on the board. Divide the class into two (2) groups and label the first group as *Player 1*, and the second group as *Player 2*. Any student from each group can raise their hand to try and answer. Whoever raises his/her hand first, will be the one who gets a turn. Each student cannot answer more than once



**Game Instructions:** The game is played similar to a regular game of Tic-Tac-Toe but with three (3) players.

The instructor will ask a question to *Players 1* and *2*. If *Player 1* gets it correct, s/he can draw a "O" figure on the board. If *Player 2* gets it correct, s/he can draw a " $\Delta$ " figure on the board. If neither player gets it correct, the instructor (labeled as *Player 3*) will answer the question and draw a " $\times$ " on the board. Keep playing until a group gets three (3) of their figures in a row/column/diagonal.



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
